AIRROC NJ 2021 – FAQ and COVID Protocols
(as of 8/30/21 policies and procedures may change)

What are the safety protocols AIRROC is taking to ensure we keep our delegates and staff safe?

Your health and safety remain our top priority. All delegates, staff, and vendors will be required to either (1) be fully vaccinated to attend our event, or (2) provide proof of a negative test that was taken no more than 48 hours before your arrival at the event.

All attendees will be required to show proof of vaccination (or negative test) upon check in. Acceptable forms of proof include a hard copy or electronic image of your vaccination card, or a verification of your clear status via one of the mobile apps widely available for vaccine passports. You must have received your final dose of vaccine by October 3 to be considered fully vaccinated before our event.

Hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the venue. We will continue to work closely with the venue and comply with all CDC guidelines.

How many people will be allowed to attend the in-person event?

In accordance with current rules for New Jersey, there is no attendance cap at the event. AIRROC will abide by NJ local and CDC recommendations at the time of the event.

Will all speakers be in-person in New Jersey?

At this time, we are expecting all speakers to be in person at the event.

Do I need to wear a mask during the in-person event?

The current policy set by the Governor of New Jersey is that if you are vaccinated you do not have to wear a mask in public spaces. If you are not vaccinated, you do have to wear a mask in

public spaces. AIRROC reserves the right to require attendees to wear masks during certain functions during the event.

I am sick and can no longer attend the physical event, or my company changed their travel policies. Will I receive a refund or credit?

All registration fees are fully refundable. No questions asked.

What happens if a change in government rules prevents me from traveling to the event or AIRROC must cancel the event?

We will continue to follow any government regulations and if conditions do not allow us to proceed with our event, we will move to a virtual format. AIRROC will make a final decision on whether to move to a virtual format no later than September 15, 2021. We will be in communication with all registered attendees on next steps.

I got vaccinated over 6 months ago. Will I require a booster shot?

CDC has not yet released a requirement of a booster shot but we will follow all recommended guidelines and continue to communicate with all registered attendees.

Please note – this policy may be updated and changed by AIRROC at any time to both comply with local and CDC guidelines and to ensure the safety of our attendees. More information on our process and procedures will be made available as we get closer to the date of the event.
