The Non-Insurtechs – How Technology Focused Insurtechs Are Changing the Face of the Industry Without Selling a Single Policy

While many in the industry are aware of the flashy unicorns getting the headlines (OSCAR, Lemonade, Ladders, PolicyGenius), just as many “under the radar” companies are having broader impact on the industry through their accretive technology services.
