In one of the biggest insurance decisions of 2016, the New York Court Appeals held that the "all sums" allocation method applied where the relevant policies contained "noncumulation" and "prior insurance" provisions. The court rejected the pro rata approach advocated by the carriers and, in separately addressing "vertical vs. horizontal exhaustion," held that only vertical exhaustion is consistent with the all sums allocation scheme. Explore in detail the ruling and the impact on policies and coverages.
